Please note that the KCC process for penalty notices (fines) has changed.


These can now be instigated if a child has more than 10 unauthorised absences (O) or 10 unauthorised lates (U) during a period of 100 possible school sessions (50 days) these do not have to be consecutive.

If a penalty application is actioned it will be issued to each parent.
