If all tasks are completed, a bonus of 5 points will be awarded.

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Using Lego or building blocks, explore numbers to 20. Build towers of different numbers of bricks up to 20. Then break in two to see what your two part numbers are.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Pick an animal. Draw a picture of your animal and write descriptive sentences about it. Don't forget finger spaces, capital letters and full stops!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Choose a book from the top 100 to read.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>DT</u></p> <p>Make a model of a person or an animal.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science- Animals</u></p> <p>Find out which animals are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography- Habitats</u></p> <p>What animals can you find where you live? Look under things in your garden or go for a walk and write down what you find.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>We have learnt different ways of writing an 'a' sound. Can you make a list of words that contain the different ways? E.g. paid, say, acorn, cake.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art</u></p> <p>Draw/paint a picture of your pet. If you don't have one, draw a picture of a pet you would like!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Listen to the song 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams. How does the song make you feel? What does it make you think of? Can you clap to the pulse of the song? (Remember the pulse is the steady beat in the song and it doesn't change).</p>
